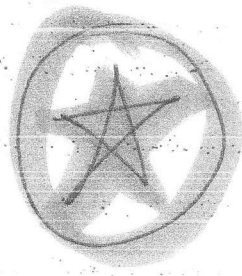

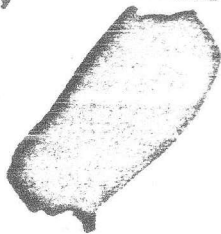

THIS INVESTIGATION. NO INFORMATION HAS BEEN DEVELOPED TO DATE RE HOFFA'S POSSIBLE PRESENCE AT RALEIGH HOUSE ON JULY 30, 1975.

[REDACTED] HAS ALSO BEEN ELIMINATED AS POSSIBLY BEING IDENTICAL TO [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] AGAIN CALLED [REDACTED] DURING THE EVENING OF OCTOBER 15, 1975, AND FURNISHED INFORMATION WHICH MAY BE HELPFUL IN NARROWING DOWN THE NUMBER OF INTERVIEWS OF EMPLOYEES WHO MAY BE IN A POSITION TO FURNISH PERTINENT INFORMATION. SHE CONTINUES TO REFUSE TO MAKE HER IDENTITY KNOWN OR AGREE TO MEET WITH AN AGENT. THIS PHASE OF THE INVESTIGATION IS RECEIVING CLOSE AND PREFERRED ATTENTION IN ORDER TO BRING IT TO A LOGICAL CONCLUSION AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.

RE: ATTORNEY [REDACTED] A CLOSE PERSONAL AND BUSINESS FRIEND OF HOFFA

[REDACTED] WAS INTERVIEWED BY MIAMI AGENTS ON OCTOBER 6, 1975, DURING WHICH HE STATED HE AND HOFFA WERE THE CLOSEST OF FRIENDS AND HE, [REDACTED] WOULD HAVE DONE ANYTHING FOR HIM.

[REDACTED] DOES NOT REPRESENT THE TEAMSTERS UNION IN ANY WAY AND

CONSIDERS FRANK FITZSIMMONS A PUPPET OF THE UNDERWORLD FACTIONS. HE LAST SAW HOFFA IN APRIL, 1975, AND LAST SPOKE TO HIM IN MAY, 1975, DURING WHICH HOFFA ASSURED HIM THAT ATTORNEY GENERAL LEVI WOULD RULE UNCONSTITUTIONAL THAT PORTION OF HIS PARDON FORBIDDING HIS INVOLVEMENT IN UNION ACTIVITIES UNTIL 1980. [REDACTED] CONSIDERS [REDACTED] AN INGRATE AND AN OPPORTUNIST WHO WAS A SOURCE OF EMBARRASSMENT TO HOFFA. HE PERSONALLY FEELS THAT THE "MOB" IS BEHIND HOFFA'S DISAPPEARANCE AND IF IT WAS TO [REDACTED] ADVANTAGE HE WOULD HAVE BEEN INSTRUMENTAL IN HOFFA'S DISAPPEARANCE. [REDACTED] SAID HE WOULD BE WILLING TO APPEAR BEFORE THE FGJ IN DETROIT AT HIS OWN EXPENSE AND WOULD WAIVE HIS FIFTH AMENDMENT PRIVILEGE.

[REDACTED] FURTHER ADVISED THAT HE WAS OUT OF THE COUNTRY ON BUSINESS WHEN HOFFA DISAPPEARED AND WAS UPSET AFTER HE RETURNED WHEN [REDACTED] CALLED HIM AND INSINUATED THAT HE MAY HAVE KNOWN ABOUT THE DISAPPEARANCE AND HAD BEEN EITHER TOLD OR DECIDED TO GET OUT OF THE COUNTRY.

[REDACTED] PERSONAL CAR, A 1975 LINCOLN, WAS REPOSSESSED BY FALCON INTERNATIONAL COMPANY, NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, AT THE REQUEST OF THE PONTIAC, MICHIGAN, STATE BANK, DUE TO NO PAYMENTS HAVING BEEN MADE ON IT SINCE JUNE, 1975. AGENTS CONDUCTED A SEARCH OF THE CAR AND THE ONLY ITEMS FOUND WHICH WARRANT FURTHER INVESTIGATION ARE THREE SETS OF SUNGLASSES, ONE OF WHICH HAD THE NAME OF A SOUTHFIELD, MICHIGAN, OPTOMETRIST ON THE CASE. THE OPTOMETRIST IS BEING INTERVIEWED.

ON OCTOBER 15, 1975, ORAL ARGUMENTS WERE HEARD ON THE MERIT OF THE PROBABLE CAUSE FOR THIS WARRANT BEFORE THE SIXTH CIRCUIT COURT IN CINCINNATI. SPECIAL ATTORNEY STANLEY HUNTERTON, DETROIT STRIKE FORCE, ADVISED THAT [REDACTED] [REDACTED] ATTORNEY FOR [REDACTED]; ALSO WAS PRESENT. NO DATE WAS SET FOR A DECISION IN THIS MATTER; HOWEVER, MR. HUNTERTON ADVISED A DECISION COULD BE ANNOUNCED WITHIN ONE MONTH FROM DATE OF ORAL ARGUMENTS.

SOURCE OF MANY NEWSPAPER STORIES CONCERNING THE HOFFA INVESTIGATION WHICH ARE ADVERSE TO BOTH FITZSIMMONS AND THE TEAMSTERS UNION.

ON OCTOBER 10, 1975, FITZSIMMONS WAS INTERVIEWED BY FBI AGENTS AT RANCHO LA COSTA, LA COSTA, CALIFORNIA, AT WHICH TIME HE MADE SOME SPECIFIC COMPLAINTS, NONE AGAINST FBI PERSONNEL.

REFERENCED AIRTEL FROM WASHINGTON FIELD WITH A SERIES OF ATTACHMENTS WERE RECEIVED BY THE DETROIT OFFICE OF THE FBI. THE SOURCES, WHICH WERE CHARACTERIZED IN A NUMBER OF WAYS, BUT NEVERTHELESS UNIDENTIFIED, ARE UNKNOWN TO THE DETROIT OFFICE. THE DETROIT OFFICE OF THE FBI IS IN NO WAY RESPONSIBLE FOR RELEASING DEFAMATORY OR DEROGATORY INFORMATION TO THE NEWS MEDIA, ON FRANK E. FITZSIMMONS OR THE TEAMSTERS.

NO INFORMATION HAS BEEN DEVELOPED TO DATE WHICH SHOWS ANY DIRECT EVIDENCE BETWEEN ABOVE BOMBING AND INSTANT MATTER.

SERVED WITH A SUBPOENA ON OCTOBER 15, 1975, ORDERING HER TO APPEAR BEFORE THE FGJ IN DETROIT FOR QUESTIONING RE THIS BOMBING AND THE INVOLVEMENT OF [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] FROM AKRON, OHIO, WHO HAS SPENT THE LAST [REDACTED] MONTHS DOING [REDACTED] INTO CRIMINAL INFLUENCE INTO THE TEAMSTERS UNION, WAS INTERVIEWED ON OCTOBER 15, AND OCTOBER 16, 1975. [REDACTED]

ADVANCES A THEORY THAT MANY INCIDENTS OF TEAMSTER RELATED VIOLENCE WERE THE WORK OF AN ANTI-HOFFA ELEMENT WITHIN THE UNION HEADED PRIMARILY BY ROLLAND MC MASTER, TEAMSTER GENERAL ORGANIZER IN THE FIELD OF STEEL AND SPECIAL COMMODITIES. *m sak*

[REDACTED] PROVIDED A GREAT DEAL OF INFORMATION FROM A SOURCE WHO CLAIMS TO HAVE WORKED FOR ROLLAND MC MASTER IN "TASK FORCE" COMPRISED OF ABOUT 15 MEN WHOSE OVERT PURPOSE WAS TO ORGANIZE NON-UNION TRUCKERS; BUT WHOSE ACTUAL PURPOSE WAS TO INSTIGATE LABOR VIOLENCE AND UNREST. ALLEGEDLY, MC MASTER WOULD THEN EXTORT MONEY FROM TRUCKING FIRMS FOR A GUARANTEE OF LABOR PEACE.

FORCE", ACTING ON ORDERS FROM ABOVE, ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR VARIOUS INSTANCES OF LABOR VIOLENCE, INCLUDING HOFFA'S DISAPPEARANCE. [REDACTED] APPEARS SINCERE, RESOURCEFUL, COOPERATIVE, AND IS ATTEMPTING TO CONVINCE HIS PRIMARY SOURCE TO COOPERATE WITH THE FBI.

RE: DETROIT LCN

LCN SOURCES IN DETROIT CONTINUE TO ADVISE THERE IS NO TALK AMONG THE LCN FIGURES ABOUT THE HOFFA DISAPPEARANCE. THESE SOURCES FEEL THAT IF THE LCN WAS NOT INVOLVED IT WOULD BE DISCUSSING THE MATTER OPENLY AND WOULD BE CONDUCTING ITS OWN INVESTIGATION IN AN EFFORT TO DETERMINE WHO WAS RESPONSIBLE IN ORDER TO STOP THE BAD PUBLICITY THE LCN IS NOW RECEIVING.

[REDACTED] ADVISED BEING EXTREMELY UPSET OVER A SERIES OF ARTICLES "THE DETROIT NEWS" IS GOING TO RUN COMMENCING OCTOBER 14, 1975, IN WHICH "THE DETROIT NEWS" PRINTS QUOTES MADE BY HIM TO THE FBI. HE STATED THAT HE HAS TOTAL CONFIDENCE IN SECURITY OF THE INFORMATION HE HAS PROVIDED TO THE FBI, HOWEVER, HE HAS ABSOLUTELY NO CONFIDENCE IN THE MICHIGAN STATE POLICE

AND FEELS THAT THEY ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR FURNISHING INFORMATION HE PROVIDED TO THEM TO THE NEWS MEDIA IN ORDER TO EMBARRASS AND DISCREDIT HIM. [REDACTED] SAID HE BELIEVES THIS IS BASED ON HIS REFUSAL TO SUBMIT TO A MICHIGAN STATE POLICE ADMINISTERED POLYGRAPH EXAM.

[REDACTED] CONTINUES TO PROVIDE INFORMATION ON A DAILY BASIS AND REMAINS EXTREMELY COOPERATIVE WITH THE FBI.

ADMINISTRATIVE:

THIS INFORMATION IS BEING SET FORTH UNDER ADMINISTRATIVE DATA INASMUCH AS IT IS NOT TO BE DISSEMINATED OUTSIDE THE BUREAU UNTIL VERIFIED.

[REDACTED] ADVISED HE HAD PREVIOUSLY PROVIDED WRITTEN ANONYMOUS INFORMATION TO "THE DETROIT NEWS SECRET WITNESS PLAN" AND THE FBI IN EARLY AUGUST, 1975, REGARDING THE DISAPPEARANCE OF HOFFA.

DROVE BY THE MACHUS RED FOX RESTAURANT. HE FOLLOWED AND FOR A DISTANCE OF THREE MILES THEREAFTER, A VEHICLE WHICH EXITED FROM THE RED FOX PARKING LOT. THE DESCRIPTION PROVIDED ON THE CAR WAS IDENTICAL TO THE ONE OWNED BY [REDACTED] (AND SEIZED BY THE FBI.)

HE STATED IN THAT VEHICLE WERE FOUR (4) WHITE MALES, ONE (1) OF WHOM HE POSITIVELY IDENTIFIED AS JAMES R. HOFFA. ALTHOUGH UNAWARE OF IDENTITY OF DRIVER AT THE TIME, HE STATED THAT SHORTLY THEREAFTER HE OBSERVED PHOTOGRAPHS OF [REDACTED] IN THE NEWSPAPER AND STATED HE IS POSITIVE THE DRIVER OF THE CAR WAS [REDACTED]

HE COULD NOT IDENTIFY THE OTHER TWO (2) INDIVIDUALS AND SAID THAT HOFFA'S HANDS APPEARED TO BE BOUND BEHIND HIS BACK. THE CAR WENT OUT OF HIS VIEW GOING SOUTH ON TELEGRAPH ROAD NEAR 12 MILE ROAD IN A HEAVY TRAFFIC JAM.

[REDACTED] HAS AGREED TENTATIVELY TO SUBMIT TO A POLYGRAPH AND IS EXTREMELY AFRAID OF HAVING HIS IDENTITY MADE KNOWN AS HE IS IN EXTREME FEAR FOR HIS FAMILY.
